The logistics of scheduling the suite and accommodating as many as possible is a difficult one, therefore, we are asking those who are scheduled to review the following rules and policies:

ALUMNI SUITE RULES AND POLICY

- 1. It is the responsibility of each member to ensure his (2) tickets are properly used, either by trading or giving them to another scheduled member.**
- 2. Each scheduled member must confirm with the Captain of the assigned game at least one week in advance, whether he will be attending , or whom he has traded with or assigned his tickets.**
- 3. If the member has not confirmed by e-mail or phone one week prior, the Captain will re-assign the tickets and notify the member by e-mail or phone that their tickets have been re-assigned.**
- 4. Failure to comply, will be noted and will result in deletion from the next suite allocation.**
- 5. Members who are not assigned tickets in the Suite, but in attendance in lower bowl seats, are welcome to visit the Suite between periods, but must return to their seats when the game resumes.**
- 6. All guests visiting the Suite between periods must be accompanied by an Alumni member. Children and family of Alumni must also be accompanied by the Member.**
- 7. The dress code in the Suite is Business Casual. “No blue jeans”**
 - To avoid embarrassment, please inform guest at time of invite.**
- 8. Recognized members of the hockey fraternity visiting GM Place will be allowed between period on a discretionary basis.**
